Florence Crittenton's Annual Luncheon to host Simone Biles as Featured Guest

Florence Crittenton is honored to have Olympic gold medalist and foster care advocate **Simone Biles** participating in a moderated Q&A at the 15th annual luncheon. The program and luncheon will begin at 11:45 a.m. with a VIP meet and greet reception with Simone Biles starting at 11 a.m.

At the age of three, Biles was placed in the foster care system and was later adopted by her grandparents who encouraged her to dream big. At the 2016 Rio Olympics, Biles earned five medals, four of them gold.

"I look forward to sharing my story with the girls of Florence Crittenton and those who attend this luncheon," said Simone Biles. "I think it's important for people to know that even if you're a foster kid, you can still fulfill your dreams, achieve greatness and be all that you can be."

Co-chairs for the 15th annual luncheon are **Tahnia McKeever**, Chair of Florence Crittenton's Board of Directors, and **Cathy Stein**, former Florence Crittenton board member and long-time supporter of the agency. Presented by BillingTree and sponsored by MicroAge, the event will include a VIP meet-and-greet, a silent auction, Dream Bags, Mystery Boxes and a HOPE Award presentation.
